Plans for the 2010-2011 School Year are under way. The School Board made a recommendation to give the staff a three percent increase for the next school year. Last year, the staff did not receive a salary adjustment.

Tuition will increase to allow for salary adjustments. The increase is an additional \$10 per month (grade school) and \$5 per month (preschool) based on twelve payments. CCS tuition still remains lower than most Christian Schools in the East Valley. New Applications will be available in February.

God has provide many people who help in so many ways: people who clean, people who donate bathroom supplies, people who donate snacks, and people with technology experience.

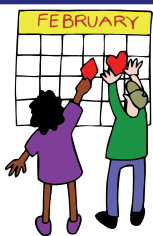

Tips on Bible Memory
